ENM-Rotate and Move
Feeding, Loafing and
Sacrifice

ENHANCEMENT: Feeding, loafing, and sacrifice areas will be rotated and located 100' or more away from streams or drains to distribute high concentrations of nutrients from animal waste and avoid erosion.

BENEFITS

(SHORT DESCRIPTION OF ENHANCEMENT BENEFITS)

- This activity results in more even distribution of animal waste throughout the pasture. Soil erosion is reduced by decreasing animal concentrations which destroy vegetation. The uniform distribution of waste provides for predictable recycled plant nutrients and uniform supplemental fertilizer application thereby reducing dependency on energy dependent manufactured fertilizer and the potential for over application of fertilizer which can impair water quality.

CRITERIA

To be eligible for this enhancement payment, fields must meet the following criteria.

- A planned rotation of areas for providing supplemental feed must provide all weather access, not be used more than once per calendar year and avoid areas excessively wet, located more than 100' or more away from streams or drains, on highly permeable soils and subject to erosion due to any obvious means such as shallow top soil, excessive overland flow or lack of adequate vegetation.
- Identified areas shall have the animal waste evenly distributed over their surface by use of a spike tooth harrow or similar implement at least once annually.
- Fertilization on the identified areas shall be based on Nutrient Management, Std. 590.
