EPM-Control invasive Exotic Species

ENHANCEMENT: Control invasive exotic species (Chinese Privet, Oriental Bittersweet, Japanese Stiltgrass, etc.) to improve production and conserve native species by hand removal or chemical application within incidental areas.

BENEFITS

(SHORT DESCRIPTION OF ENHANCEMENT BENEFITS)

- The extra effort of exotic plant pests even if below threshold levels is part of a comprehensive control activity that must occur if these types of pests are ever to be eliminated. Ignoring invasive weeds and plants when present at any population density only insures their continued presence and ultimate increase and spread.

CRITERIA

To be eligible for this enhancement payment the following criteria must be met.

- The weed must be verified as invasive exotic by The North Carolina Botanical Gardens or Nature Serve (a web based pest identification service of The Nature Conservancy).
- The identified species must be eliminated from the site for at least three years.

RECORDKEEPING

In order to verify performance with these criteria, you must complete the following records.
